ABOUT THIS EXHIBITION:

Lyme Art Association member artists of all categories may submit up to four (4) works of art in this un-juried exhibition. All work must be representational and paintings, drawings, hand-pulled prints and sculpture are eligible. All work will be displayed on table-top easels in the center of the galleries, with over-flow around the perimeter on the floor.

THIS IS AN UN-JURIED SHOW

Members seeking Associate or Elected Artist status may not count this as an acceptance to an LAA exhibition.

Receiving Days: Wed & Thu, July 26 & 27 from 10 - 5pm

Early entries must be approved by LAA Staff. Call during business hours to make arrangements.

Please do not drop off artwork before July 26 without advanced permission.

Entry Fees:

Individual & Associate Artist Fees: \$10 for 1st piece & \$5 per each additional.

Elected Artist Fees: \$15 covers all entries.

Removal of Artwork: Wed, Aug. 2nd & Thur. Aug. 3rd 10 - 5pm

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- All work must be for sale and LAA Membership dues must be current.
- Photographs, off-set lithographs, and other prints made using xerographic, digital, or photographic processes do not qualify.
- **NEW** - Frames are not required. Unframed works on paper must be backed in cardboard and wrapped in clear plastic.
- **All submissions of work and materials are at the artist's sole risk.** The LAA assumes no responsibility for loss or damage during the exhibition or subsequent storage at the close of the show. Artists agree to commit accepted works for the duration of the exhibition. The entry of your artwork in this exhibition constitutes your acceptance of these terms.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SALE OF ARTWORK:

Checks and credit card payment for purchase of artwork, including CT sales tax, shall be made out to the LAA. **If the artwork is sold, 35% of the sale price will be retained by the LAA and 65% of the sale price will be remitted to the artist by check**
