The exhibition will be hung in the Cooper/Ferry, Caddell and Cole Galleries. A separate show, *Connecticut Watercolor Society*, will run concurrently in the Goodman Gallery.

**Open to:** Elected Artist Members **ONLY**

**Elected Artist Submission Fee:** \$25. Artists may submit up to six pieces.

**Juror:** Rebekah Beaulieu, Ph.D., Director Florence Griswold Museum

**Receiving Dates:** Thursday, Friday and Saturday, April 18, 19 & 20, 10am-5pm.

**Acceptance List:** Will be posted on our website on Wed., April 24 by 5pm.

**On View Dates:** April 26th

**Opening Reception Date:** Sunday, May 5, 2 – 4 pm.

**Removal Date:** Saturday & Sunday, June 8th and June 9th, 10am – 5pm.

All participants are eligible to receive one of the following awards:

**1<sup>st</sup> prize: \$500**

**2<sup>nd</sup> prize: \$250**

**3<sup>rd</sup> prize: \$125**

**People's Choice: \$100**

### Entry Requirements

- You must be an Elected Artist to submit. Membership dues must be current.
- All work must be for sale, be framed or gallery wrapped, signed on front or back, and wired for hanging.
- Work for this exhibition must be original in concept and execution and must have been created in the last 3 years.
- Work that has been shown at the LAA in any previous juried exhibition or has been done under tutelage may not be submitted.
- All work will be juried with no guarantees. Decisions by the juror are final.
- Photographs, off-set lithographs, and other prints made using xerographic, digital, or photographic processes do not qualify.
- **PLEASE, NO WET PAINTINGS!**
- The LAA reserves the right to rent the gallery for outside events and to move work, when necessary, for these events.
- **While the utmost care will be taken in handling all works, the LAA, its directors and agents assume no liability for damage, loss or theft of submitted work. All artists are responsible for insuring their own work. Artists agree to commit accepted works for the duration of the exhibition. The LAA reserves the right to not include any piece submitted for entry.**
- **Artwork left at the LAA for more than 90 days after the end of the exhibition will become the property of LAA.**
- **The submission of work to the exhibition constitutes an agreement on the part of the artist or artist's agent to these conditions.**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SALE OF ARTWORK:** Checks and credit card payment for purchase of artwork, including CT sales tax, shall be made out to the LAA. **If the artwork is sold, 35% of the sale price will be retained by the LAA and 65% of the sale price will be remitted to the artist by check from the LAA.** The LAA will retain and remit the sales tax. As a not-for-profit organization, the LAA provides the artists with an opportunity to exhibit but does not assume the role of agent or representative.
