## **Materials List**

\*\*Please bring one or two NON-FLASH photo references of your subject with a good light and shadow pattern large enough to work from ( a headshot might be a good choice)

#### **DRAWING**

Charcoal and Chalk

Assorted 2B, 4B, HB charcoal pencils and white chalk

PAPER

11x14 or 12x16 charcoal sketch pad white or gray toned

- · drawing board if you want to tape paper onto it
- ERASERS kneaded and gum eraser
- Blending stumps varying sizes
- Pencil Sharpener or razor blade and sandpaper sharpener

### **PAINTING**

- Paints (professional oil based), Try to buy the same brand of paints except for white;
  Gamblin is a good choice
  - o Titanium White, Permalba Original is a good brand for white, **150ml**
  - Ivory Black 37ml
  - Cadmium Yellow Light 37 ml
  - o Cadmium Red Medium 37 ml
  - Cobalt Blue 37ml
  - Ultramarine Blue 37ml

#### **BRUSHES**

- Long handle flat bristle brushes for oil, Robert Simmons 40 F series is a good choice
  - # 2, 4, 6 or 8 (small, medium, large)
  - One small long-handled sable cat's tongue brush, Silver Renaissance #2 for whiskers!

## **CANVAS**

11x14 or 12x16 canvas or canvas board, acrylic or oil primed cotton or linen



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### **PALETTE**

- Wood, glass or disposable palette wood is best, make sure it is large enough to mix on
- Palette knife, a small triangular palette knife for mixing, Creative Mark makes a T3

## **MEDIUM**

- Gamsol Odorless Mineral Spirits
- Turpentine Washer with strainer or mediu-size glass jar with lid
- Cold-pressed or refined linseed oil

## **OTHER**

Roll of paper towels Bar of Ivory Soap
