Dear LAA Associate Artist:

There are two important submission deadlines to remember when submitting an application for Elected Artist status. Artists must submit their paperwork (in person or via email) by **Sunday August 11, 2024.** Artwork must be physically dropped off between Wednesday August 21 through Saturday August 24, 2024. Associate Artists who meet all eligibility requirements should carefully review this letter and the following application.

Applying tobe an Elected Artist of the Lyme Art Association signifies that youconsider yourself to be an accomplished artist, having concentrated on pursuing your craft, and having attained a level of skill, distinction, and recognition. As part of the application, six works created within the last 3 years must be submitted. These may include works previously shown in LAA exhibitions, but no works done under tutelage.

The Mission of the Lyme Association, as a non-profit organization, is to promote and cultivate an appreciation for representational fine arts by holding art exhibitions, conducting educational programs for the benefit of its members and the greater community and by owning, maintaining, and preserving a historic building and galleries in Old Lyme, Connecticut.

Elected Artists provide the support to sustain the mission of the LAA. Their presence and willingness to serve are paramount to the ongoing success of the LAA.

Elected Artists vote on major issues once a year, at the Fall Membership Meeting.

Elected Artist dues are \$95 a year and must be kept current. Entry fees and number of works entered into an exhibition vary; however Elected Artists receive a discount.

Elected artist Membership allows artists a stronger voice in the LAA's activities, including an opportunity to be nominated to serve on the Board of Directors or the Artistic Policy and Exhibition Committee (APEC). As a Board committee, APEC represents all the artists in the organization, and works with LAA administrative staff to manage exhibitions and other operations.

Elected Artists may also serve on other committees, such as the Nominating Committee and the Screening Committee. The Nominating Committee recommends EAs to serve on the Board of Directors. The Screening Committee previews applications for EA status and recommends applicants for voting approval by the full body of the EAs. There are many ways Elected Artists can volunteer, ranging from exhibition and education programs to business operations.

Selected work by Elected Artists will be featured in LAA publicity and will be shown on and linked to the LAA website. EAs are invited to display one small work in the Elected Artist Gallery on the main floor of the Association.

Lyme Art Association Elected Artist Member Application

Paperwork for Elected Artist Applications is due by Sunday August 11, 2024. Artwork must be dropped off between Wednesday August 21 - Saturday August 24, 2024. You must be an Associate Artist Member who has exhibited a minimum of three works as an Associate Artist in LAA juried exhibitions

within a two-year period. **You must submit six works.** Sculptors may request pedestals from LAA if they are available. These works may not have been done under instruction and must be current (done within the last 3 years). If applying for both designations the applicant must fulfill the submission requirements of both categories.

A fee of \$40 is required with your application. Please fill out the enclosed Inventory Sheet and Tags and attach tags to each work submitted.

There are two phases of the application process.

Phase One: A Screening Committee of 5 Elected Artists selected by the APEC committee, will review the portfolios and vote to approve or decline the work for presentation to all Elected Artists. Those applicants who make it through Phase One will be displayed in the Downstairs *Mile Brook* Gallery to be voted on by current LAA Elected Artists.

Phase Two: Current LAA Elected Artists vote in person, by sealed ballot from 9/6 - 10/9. A two-thirds majority of those voting is necessary for approval. Emailed notice of results will be sent to the applicants on Oct. 10.

Please use the following timetable as a guide when preparing your application:

- Sunday, August 11: Deadline for EA Candidates to Submit Paperwork
- Wednesday Saturday, August 21-24: Artwork Drop Off
- August 30: Work Approved by Screening Committee
- Sunday September 1: Applicant is notified of status by email
- September 6 October 9: Elected Artist Voting Period
- Wednesday, October 9: Annual Membership Meeting and last day to vote.
- Thursday, October 10: Applicant is notified of status by email

A word to the applicant: Applying to be an Elected Artist Member of the Lyme Art Association signifies that you consider yourself to be an accomplished artist, having attained a notable level of skill, distinction, and recognition. Your submission should be a well presented, cohesive body of work, not necessarily restricted to one medium or subject matter.

Screeners and Elected Artists will be looking at the following criteria in evaluating the portfolios:

- 1. Composition Is the work well designed? Does your eye move through the piece effectively?
- 2. Technique Is the artist a master of their materials?
- 3. Presentation Does the presentation (frames, mats...) complement the pieces?

4. Consistent body of work – Do the pieces hang well together? Is the artist's style present throughout the pieces with consistent quality?
