Drawing Fall Leaves

Materials:

Pencils - assorted colors- I will be using Faber Castell Polychromos pencils for the majority of the class but please feel free to use whichever brand you prefer! I will also be using some individual pencils from other brands as necessary.

Paper - Stonehenge Aqua Hotpress paper 10 x14 minimum size, larger is fine.
We will be adding our leaves to the same page each week so there should be enough room on the page for each leaf. Alternatively, you can create a single leaf on a single page each week for a smaller, one subject study. You don't have to decide that now:)

Erasers, sharpeners -the Swordfish Ikon is a favorite of mine these days.

Tracing paper
Sketch paper, nothing fancy
Graphite pencils
Micron pen or Molotow pen for stippling

Watercolor, either pans or watercolor pencils. This is not a mandatory material, just something you are welcome to experiment with along with me. I will be creating a leaf using watercolor along with colored pencil for one of the class times.

Finally,
LEAVES! Colorful is fun, if you can't find any "good" colorful leaves search around the garden centers as they usually have spent leaves that drop off - think coleus & kale
Spent, browning, curled leaves are also a great subject!
