## **Materials List**

PAINTS (professional OIL BASED) Try to buy the same brand of paints except for white; Gamblin is a good choice

Titanium White, Permalba Original is a good brand for white, 150ml

Cadmium Yellow Light 37 ml

Cadmium Orange 37 ml

Cadmium Red Medium 37 ml

Cobalt Blue 37 ml

Ultramarine Blue 37 ml

Ivory Black 37 ml

Alizarin Crimson 37 ml

#### **BRUSHES**

Long Handle flat bristle brushes for oil, Robert Simmon 40F series is a good choice #2, # 4 and # 6 or # 8, i.e., small, medium, and large) and a tall can to house them (like a pringles can)

One small long-handled sable 'cat's tongue' brush (Silver Renaissance #2)



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### **CANVAS**

11 x 14 or 12x16 stretched canvas or canvas board *acrylic or oil primed cotton or linen* 

# PALETTE (for oil paint)

Wood, glass, or disposable paper palette around 12x16 (make sure it is big enough to mix on, no plastic palette with pre-formed molded cups)

Saran wrap (to cover paints if you want to save in freezer)

Palette knife (a small triangular palette knife for mixing; Creative Mark makes a T3)

#### **MEDIUM**

Gamsol Odorless Mineral Spirits or any Odorless mineral spirits

Turpentine Washer with strainer or medium-sized glass jar with lid

Cold-pressed or Refined Linseed Oil and a small lidded cup to hold oil



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## **OTHER**

Roll of Paper Towels, Bar of Ivory Soap

Large tote to carry supplies with pockets or receptacles to hold liquid
