## Watercolors Materials List

*Bring all your favorite materials for watercolor painting.*

### Watercolor paper:

Rough or Cold press paper is recommended - minimum of 140lb

### Brushes: assorted sizes:

Large wash brush or hake brush

1 1/2" flat - either synthetic or natural bristle

1-inch flat brush

#6 round brush

### Colors:

This is my favorite palette, but bring the colors you use and we will work with them. I use American Journey and Daniel Smith paints:

- Raw sienna
- Cad yellow light
- Yellow ochre
- Alizarin Crimson
- Quinacridone red
- Light red
- Burnt umber
- Ultramarine blue
- Cerulean blue
- Prussian Blue
- Payne's grey

### Other Supplies:

Bring your favorite drawing pencils and kneaded erasers for sketching.

Small sketch pad

Masking tape

Palette and easel, folding chair

Backing board for your easel

Water container (plastic or metal)

Roll of paper towels

Clips to hold paper
