

William Duffy's Plein-air Painting Workshop Materials List

Paint

Bring the oil or acrylic pigments you are comfortable with. Most of the time I use these oil pigments for painting outside.

Winsor or Cadmium yellow.

Ultramarine blue

Burnt sienna

Raw umber

Winsor red.

Winsor orange.

Yellow ochre and yellow ochre light and pale.

Sap green

Titanium white

Ivory black

Winsor & Newton Griffin Alkyd paint.

We will be using alkyds as an integral part of the workshop for toning and underpainting. I will have some alkyd for the class to use.

Ivory black

Burnt sienna

Winsor Yellow

Titanium white

Medium

Bring the medium you are comfortable with.

I use Alkyd medium for toning the canvas and under painting because it dries quickly. **I will bring some of my own Alkyd medium for the class to use.**

Use your own medium for over painting. I use 1/3 linseed oil, and 2/3 turpentine along with a couple of drops of cobalt drier. I use Turpenoid for cleaning my brushes

Brushes

Bring the brushes you are comfortable with

I use mostly flats, filberts, brights bristle brushes sizes 2-5 along with a few synthetic small rounds. **I will bring and use a large old brush and rags for toning panels for myself and the class.**

Sketch paper and pencils

Bring a few pieces (about 6x 9 inches) of light to medium gray pastel paper for value studies along with a couple of graphite office pencils and a WHITE charcoal pencil and a hand-held sharpener. I will bring some sharpeners for the class to use

Canvases or Panels

Bring the size panels or canvases that you are comfortable with while painting outside.

I will be painting on oil primed linen canvas mounted on birch panels sizes Depending on the subject's composition I will paint anywhere from 8 x12, 9x12, 11 x14 up to 8x14, 8x15, 9x16. If you like bring an old frame or two to measure your results for the paintings done in the workshop.

Easels etc.

Bring what you use painting outside

I use a Julian French easel. Bring bug spray, sun screen, paper towels, trash bags and chair or stool and an umbrella If desired.
