Materials List

- Watercolor paint: Ultramarine Blue, Quinacridone Magenta, Sap Green, Cobalt Blue, Lemon Yellow, Pyrrol Red or Cadmium Red, Burnt Umber
- Watercolor paper: one large 22x30 inch 300lbs hot press (Arches or Fabriano); This can be cut down into 4 equal pieces.
- Watercolor Round Brush: 00, 0, 01, 02 (Professional brands: Princeton velvetouch, Winsor & Newton series 7, Princeton Aqua Elite)
- 1/8" Angle Shader brush
- Water Jar
- Mixing palette - ceramic or white plastic
- Paper towel
- Pencil (mechanical HB) and white rubber eraser
- Kneaded Eraser
- Sketch or tracing paper
- *Optional: Dip pen with various nib sizes (Speedball Calligraphy Pen set has great nib sizes)*
- *Optional: Masking Flui0064*
